Before watching...

Pre-viewing activities or discussions help focus attention when watching a video and build critical thinking skills. Consider using a simple activity such as defining the character word together or having students write their own definitions before watching the story.

After Watching...

Discussion Questions

1. The kids say fairness means, “not judging someone by how they look or act,” and “treating people equally.” How do you define fairness?
2. One boy says, “What goes around, comes around.” What does that mean? How does that relate to fairness?
3. One girl says, “You have to try to be fair.” Does fairness take effort? Why or why not?
4. One girl feels that the way people pick teams is unfair, always picking the least talented person last. What do you think? Is there a better, more fair system?
5. The video closes with a boy saying, “Life’s not fair sometimes but that’s just the way it is.” Do you agree? Why or why not?
