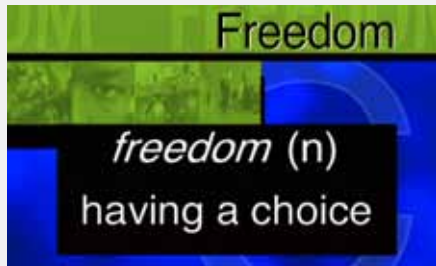


Character and Life Skills: **Freedom**

Before watching...

Pre-viewing activities or discussions help focus attention when watching a video and build critical thinking skills. Consider playing appropriate songs with the words "free" or "freedom" in the lyrics.

After Watching...

Discussion Questions

1. The kids say freedom is "being able to express yourself more openly" and "not being restricted to certain things." How do you define freedom?
2. One person says, "Freedom lets people think for themselves." Why do you think this is important?
3. Several kids talk about the freedoms they have at school, such as the freedom to dress as they want and to play outside. What freedoms do you enjoy at your school?
4. One boy says, "We need freedom to make mistakes and have experiences." What does that mean? Why would we want to have freedom to make mistakes? What experiences would you like to have?
5. The boy also says, "You need to be able to have freedom in your life." Why?
