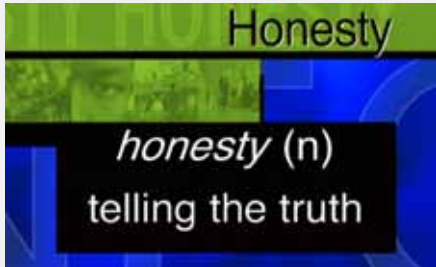


Character and Life Skills: **Honesty**

Pre-Viewing and Discussion Questions

Grade Level: **3-5**



Before watching...

Pre-viewing activities or discussions help focus attention when watching a video and build critical thinking skills. Consider using a simple activity such as defining the character word together or having students write their own definitions before watching the story.

After Watching...

Discussion Questions

1. The kids say honesty is “telling the truth, not lying” and “being truthful to everyone you encounter.” How do you define honesty?
2. One girl says that if you are honest you “fess up to what you do.” What does that mean? Do you agree or disagree? Why?
3. Several of the kids talk about how being honest makes you feel good as well as how being dishonest makes you feel bad. What is your experience with your own feelings about being honest or dishonest?
4. Why should you be honest even when you have done something bad?
