

Character and Life Skills: Honor

Pre-Viewing and Discussion Questions

Grade Level: 3-5



Before watching...

Pre-viewing activities or discussions help focus attention when watching a video and build critical thinking skills. Consider using a simple activity such as defining the character word together or having students write their own definitions before watching the story.

After Watching...

Discussion Questions

1. The kids say honor is “when you show respect for someone” and “when you praise someone for something good they did.” How do you define honor?
2. The kids give examples of the people they honor (parents, friends, brother, etc.). Who do you honor? Why?
3. One girl says she honors those who serve in the military “because they protect our country.” Do you agree or disagree with her? Explain your answer.
4. What are some ways to show you honor a person or a group of people?
5. What does it mean to be honorable?
6. Another girl says, “If you are honorable you can be a good leader.” Do you have to be honorable to be a good leader? Why or why not?
