Before watching...

Pre-viewing activities or discussions help focus attention when watching a video and build critical thinking skills. Consider using a simple activity such as defining the character word together or having students write their own definitions before watching the story.

After Watching...

Discussion Questions

1. The kids say that integrity is about “how much you believe in yourself” and “doing the right thing.” How do you define integrity?
2. One girl talks about how doing the right thing, acting with integrity, makes you feel good about yourself. If you don’t act with integrity, you feel bad and guilty. Agree or disagree with her statement and give examples to support your answer.
3. What happens when people do not act with integrity? How does that affect those around them?
4. How would you teach someone younger than you are about integrity?
