Discussion Questions

- 1. The kids say respect is "showing honor and kindness to people" and "being nice no matter what race they are" and "being nice no matter what they look like or who they are." How do you define respect?
- **2.** Several of the kids say that respect is about showing good manners. What are some examples good manners in both words and in actions?
- **3.** How do you show respect to people in your life? What do you say and do that shows respect to your parents? To teachers? To adults? To friends?
- **4.** Some people (not in this video) say that we should respect the earth. What does that mean? How does that compare/contrast to how we should respect people?
- 5. What does it mean to respect yourself?

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
